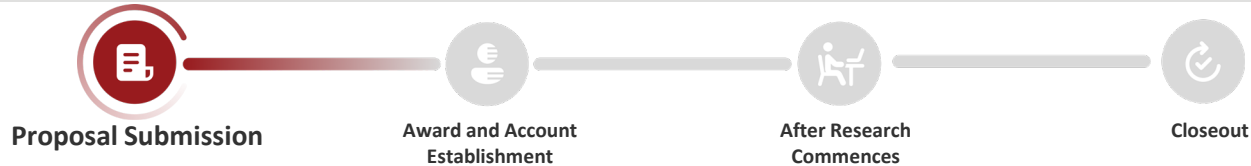

<a href="#">Vivli</a>	Per study option for individual researchers--free. There is a charge from 3rd party vendors to anonymize data, which can be \$5,000-\$10,000 depending on the amount and type.
